

4.4.4 Security Policy

INTECH has it as a policy and function to manage security affairs as an integral part of its HSE Program and company's business to minimize the number of security related incidents for all staff, customers and third-party personnel involved in her operations.

To implement this policy, INTECH shall:

- Provide adequate number of trained security personnel in all her area of operations to protect life and properties and customer facilities at work sites.
- Shall in consultation with customer's security department, establish a clear operational mode of any group of Government security agents seconded to the project. Clear line of command shall be set out and enforced.
- Engage a Security Supervisor at management level who will organize, co-ordinate and implement all the company's security programs.
- Engage local security men to protect equipment and facilities at worksites.
- All security incidents will be promptly reported to our customer and law enforcement agent (where necessary) as soon as possible.
- Provide work gadgets such as walkie-talkie, torches, uniforms etc to enhance their services.
- Review all security incidents matter on site and at management HSE meetings.
- Security matters shall form part of site/base HSE and toolbox meetings.

The security supervisor shall be the focal point and shall act in consent with relevant departments in the realization of set security objectives and targets.
